International Business Trainee Programme

Are you interested in becoming our next trainee? Our trainee programme is aimed at fresh university graduates and young talents with work experience. We are looking for business talents with a professional and personal drive.

Global Timber's IBT programme is a two-year plan with a three-month rotation in the Global Timber Company. During the two years of your traineeship, you will learn all aspects of the timber business and gain knowledge of the functions in the administration-, trades- and shipping department. The rotation is combined with courses at Aarhus Business College.

During her trainee programme Petra entered the demanding area regarding compliance with European Timber Regulation (EUTR). Petra was not the typical trainee. She moved to Denmark from Romania almost 12 years ago, carrying a university degree and the capability to speak several languages including Spanish, French, English and Romanian. Her ear for Romanic/Latin languages came in handy when she after no more than half a year as a trainee was asked to go to Brazil with one of the managers.

Being the first placer of timber in the EU market, we are responsible for the EUTR, which implies a lot of work. I am responsible for ensuring that all documents in the supply chain meet regulatory requirements and I assist with shipping and purchasing too.

With her academic background, Petra added valuable skills to the Global Timber administration and the area of compliance during her trainee. She quickly learned how to monitor and secure the management of the forests in a right way.

She enforces the importance of having a cultural awareness when you work in a global company like Global Timber:

Travelling in countries like Brazil gives you the opportunity to talk to your suppliers about sustainable and environmental matters. At the same time, you get a better understanding of how things work across countries and cultures. This gives you self-confidence and certainty in your daily work with the challenging processing of essential documents in different languages. Getting to know your partners abroad also add more knowledge to the shipment of your products.
